[UNESCO](#), a United Nations–mosey company, has called for the preservation of [Afghanistan](#)’s cultural property amid the Taliban regime’s takeover. The organization is attention-grabbing for precautions to safeguard the teach’s historical artifacts from “inconvenience and looting,” per a assertion released on Thursday.

Consultants like raised concerns about the preservation of Afghan cultural heritage, given what has took place when the Taliban like assumed strength beforehand. In 2001, Taliban forces destroyed the Bamiyan Buddhas, two huge sixth-century century statues carved into a cliff within the Bamiyan Valley within the central highlands of Afghanistan. UNESCO’s assertion talked about that Afghanistan’s cultural sites are fragment of the country’s diverse historical previous and integral to its national identity. “Any inconvenience or loss of cultural heritage will most tremendous like unfavorable consequences on the possibilities for lasting peace and humanitarian reduction for the of us of Afghanistan,” the assertion reads.

On August 15, the Nationwide Museum in Kabul raised concerns about the possibility of looting. “Kabul city has witnessed unheard of chaos. . . . Continuation of this chaotic scenario causes a broad inconvenience about the protection of museum’s artifacts and items,” the museum talked about in a assertion posted to social media.

Following the destruction of the Bamiyan statues by the Taliban two a long time ago, UNESCO instated a program with the Afghan Internal Ministry in 2004 to safeguard sites within the provinces of Logar and Kapisa near Kabul. Afghanistan is moreover dwelling to one World Heritage role overseen by UNESCO, the Minaret and Archaeological Remains of Jam within the western province of Ghor. In Can also 2019, Taliban forces seized preserve a watch on of checkpoints near the 12th-century role, barring entry to the grounds and killing 18 Afghan security personnel.

Earlier this week, Karima Bennoune, a UN Particular Rapporteur for cultural rights, issued a assertion pointing to the Taliban’s “effectively-documented” destruction of cultural property previous the Bamiyan Buddhas. “Conserving Afghan lives and rights ought to light be the tip precedence,” Bennoune talked about. “Efforts must moreover be made to make certain that the protection of all

forms of culture and cultural heritage which are very well-known for enjoyment of these rights.”
