

Exclusive: GOP Senators Slam Schumer For ‘Slandering’ Justices And Enabling Left’s ‘Authoritarian’ Tactics

A trio of Republican senators from the effective Judiciary Committee is contacting Sen. Chuck Schumer, D-N.Y., to drastically stroll back his rhetoric on the dripped *Dobbs* viewpoint, implicating the bulk leader of “slander[ing]” Supreme Court justices and allowing “authoritarian” conduct from Democrats.

In a Thursday letter initially gotten by The Federalist, Sens. Marsha Blackburn, R-Tenn., Mike Lee, R-Utah, and Ted Cruz, R-Texas, straight asked Schumer to condemn hazards versus justices and “regard” the court’s self-reliance by avoiding intimidation efforts focused on pushing the bulk into a various judgment.

Asked by The Federalist on Friday whether Schumer condemns the techniques of groups like “Ruth Sent United States,” that include releasing the supposed personal addresses of justices and showing outside their houses, the senator’s press secretary did not react. Schumer’s workplace likewise decreased to react when asked whether the dripping of Justice Alito’s draft viewpoint will subject the judicial procedure to improper external pressures.

Blackburn, Lee, and Cruz took specific concern with Schumer’s fast response to the Politico report that consisted of Alito’s February draft of the bulk viewpoint in *Dobbs* “Immediately after this draft was dripped, you assaulted the Supreme Court justices from the flooring of the Senate, and once again from the actions of the U.S. Capitol,” they composed. “Specifically, throughout your May 3, 2022 remarks on the flooring of the U.S. Senate, you mentioned, ‘Several of these conservative justices ... have actually lied to the U.S. Senate, ripped up the Constitution, and defiled both precedent and the Supreme Court’s credibility.’”

” We have major issues about your choice to slander our Supreme Court justices in order to attain your favored policy outcomes,” stated Blackburn, Lee, and Cruz, arguing that Republican-appointed justices who acknowledged *Roe* as “essential precedent” in their verification hearings did not lie, as Schumer asserted, however showed “neutrality.”

Citing *Brown v. Board* and *Loving v. Virginia*, the senators composed, “There is no concern that you support the Court reversing precedent where the Constitution and concepts of look decisis so need it– you simply do not desire the Court to reverse the precedents *you* occur to like.” They likewise pointed out Schumer’s declaration in March of 2020 that Justices Kavanaugh and Gorsuch would “pay the cost” if they chose a various case versus the leader’s desires. “This type of

inflammatory rhetoric is hazardous to our democratic system of federal government,” the letter argued.

After commemorating the viewpoint for returning choices about abortion back to the states, the letter even more pointed out Schumer’s failure to “renounce” Democrats’ require court packaging and wiping out the filibuster. “Make no error: these are methods of authoritarian leaders. Totalitarians alter the guidelines and shatter standards when they can not accomplish their political objectives through the democratic procedure,” stated the letter.

In closing, the senators contacted Schumer “to make really clear to the American individuals that all hazards and intimidation strategies versus our Supreme Court justices are abhorrent.”

” We even more advise you to promise that you will appreciate the self-reliance of the Supreme Court, despite how it rules in *Dobbs*, which you will avoid attempting to apply political pressure to affect the choices of the Court,” they included.
