Real Estate Prices On Maui's North Shore

According to information from Realtor.com, there are presently 22 houses for sale in Paia varying from \$599,000 to \$17,000,000 and 58 houses for sale in Haiku varying from \$170,000 to \$15,000,000, with a typical listing rate of \$3,700,000 million and \$1,500,000 million, respectively.

Reports carried out in October 2021 by Maui News specified that the mean prices for a single-family house in Maui County, that includes the totality of the island, stood at \$996,500 in September, a 27.3% boost from the very same month in 2015.

"The individuals who concern this part of the island are trying to find a way of life that is more personal, far from the more overloaded and touristy locations on Maui," Jerman states.

With a combined population of approximately 11,000, Haiku and Paia are ultimate Hawaii villages, suggesting a quieter, slower presence than the speed of Honolulu.

But a little population does not indicate a little culture—the location is home to lots of popular and substantial locations, consisting of landmark natural websites too a large offering of galleries, store stores and dining establishments.

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One such dining establishment, Mama's Fish House, opened in 1973, is probably the most significant dining establishment on Maui, using meals including fresh fish and regional tastes.

Other crucial cultural organizations discovered in the location are the Sacred Garden of Maliko, the Haiku Marketplace at the Haiku Cannery, and Hui No'eau Visual Arts Center, a non-degree giving recreation center for arts education.

Learning The Ins And Outs Of The North Shore School System

Two schools served by the Hawaii State Department of Education lie in the North Shore— Paia Elementary and Haiku Elementary.

In addition, a range of education choices are readily available, consisting of prep schools like Seabury Hall, parochial schools like Doris Todd Christian Academy or alternative schools like Real Ongoing Opportunities to Soar (ROOTS), along with Waldorf and Montessori schools such as Haleakala Waldorf School and Montessori School of Maui, respectively.

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Getting Around The North Shore Of Maui

When heading eastbound, Paia is thought about the very first stop on the renowned Road to Hana, which lies about 45 miles away, or a two-hour drive.

Eight miles to the west of Paia lies Kahului, where the Kahului Airport lies. From Kahului Airport, Honolulu is a brief 40- minute airplane trip.
