

Why Won't The Pulitzer Board Answer Trump On Whether Its 'Review Process' Is Legit Enough To Revoke Prizes For Russia Hoax Propaganda?



Despite formerly declaring it “has a standing procedure for examining concerns about previous awards, under the standards of which problems are thought about by a designated committee,” the Pulitzer Prize Board will not state if it is still evaluating the awards it approved to business media outlets guilty of promoting the Russia collusion scam.

In his latest letter, previous President Donald Trump threatened to take legal action against the board unless it divulges whether it prepares to rescind the awards provided to “blatantly phony, negative,

and defamatory news.”

” You have a responsibility to show me the status of that apparently ‘selected committee’s’ evaluation following its supposed ‘standing procedure,’” Trump composed on May27

Trump likewise stated the board dealt with “the publications that have actually fanatically promoted disgustingly incorrect attacks versus me” and “done all you can to damage my track record.”

“[H]ow can I get my track record back?” Trump asked.

Both The New York Times and The Washington Post got the 2018 Pulitzer Prize for National Reporting for enhancing claims that Trump conspired with Russia to interfere in the 2016 election. Regardless of years of proof showing that Hillary Clinton’s project spent for and pitched the story in an effort to sic the federal government on her political opponent Trump, the Pulitzer Prize Board has yet to rescind any of its rewards for reporting that was based upon the unmasked Steele file.

As a matter of reality, the Pulitzer web page still legitimizes the incorrect reporting linking Trump in a conspiracy to weaken the stability of U.S. elections.

” For deeply sourced, non-stop reported protection in the general public interest that significantly advanced the country’s understanding of Russian disturbance in the 2016 governmental election and its connections to the Trump project, the President-elect’s shift group and his ultimate administration,” states the page for the winning work.

The Pulitzer Board did not instantly react to The Federalist’s ask for remark.

Trump formerly corresponded in October and November requiring that the board withdraw its awards for both The New York Times and The Washington Post, mentioning lots of evidence that the business media outlets’ claims of collusion were unwarranted then and are outrageous now.

For one, Igor Danchenko, among the prime Steele file factors, was charged with lying to the FBI about dealing with Clinton’s project. Clinton’s legal representative Michael Sussmann was likewise charged and later on acquitted of comparable criminal offenses, however his trial exposed conclusive evidence that Clinton “‘ concurred with the choice’ to feed the unproven– and rapidly unmasked– theory that Trump was interacting privately with Russia through a back-door Alfa Bank channel.”

The Washington Post erased parts of 2 of its collusion scam short articles, slapped them with corrections, and entirely altered the headings to show the fact. The publication stated it “might no longer wait the precision of those components of the story.”
